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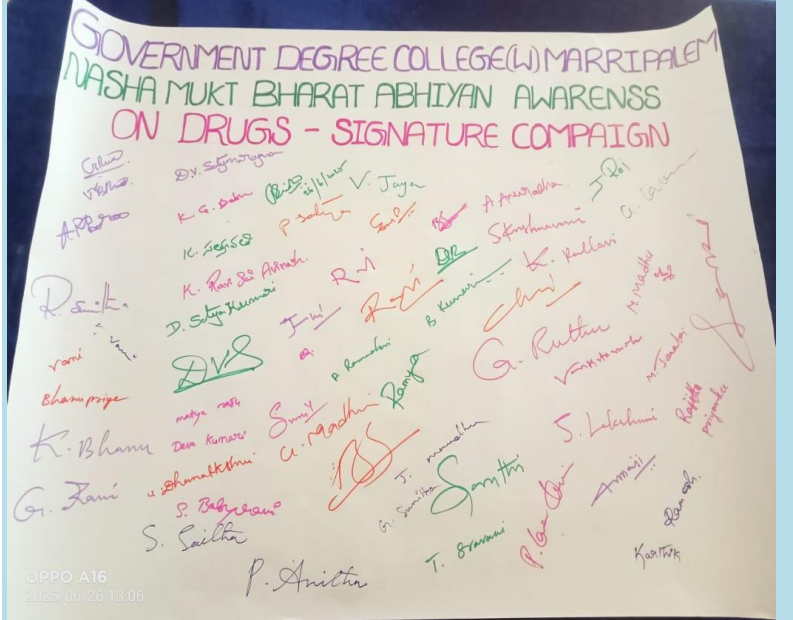
మరిపాలెంలో అంతర్జాతీయ మాదకద్రవ్యాల వ్యతిరేక దినం

The campaign created a positive impact, resulting in good responses from the public. The principal appreciated the team spirit and dedication of all the members involved in the admission drive.



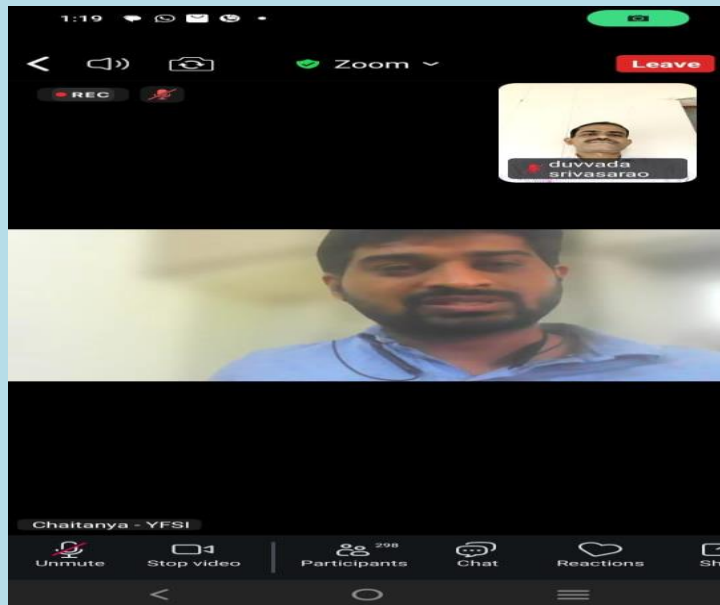
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ONLINE MEETING,
