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INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY:

The **International Yoga Day** celebrations were held at Government Degree College for Women, Marripalem on **21st June 2024**. The programme aimed to promote awareness about the importance of yoga for physical fitness, mental well-being, and a healthy lifestyle.

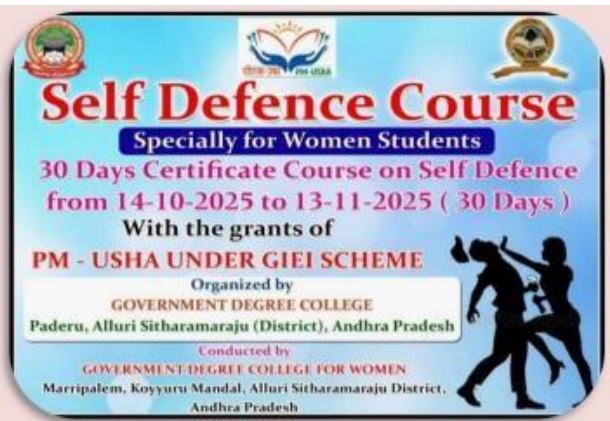
